The African continent continues to be a key emerging market. South Africa

With the introduction of South Africa into the BRIC countries and with the top stock exchange on the African continent, South Africa continues to be the one of the strongest economies in Africa, and a key political player in the African Union. Our coverage of South Africa is anchored by the major dailies including the Sunday Times, which is the largest weekly newspaper in South Africa. Published by Avusa Media (previously Johnnic Communications) the newspaper is no stranger to controversy, having recently

exposing a corruption scandal involving the South African government's US\$6 billion arms deal. Other Avusa titles on Nexis include the Sowetan, The Times (South Africa), The Herald (South Africa), the Daily Dispatch and South Africa's top business paper, Business Day.

Another key weekly is the Mail and Guardian (published by M and G Media Ltd). The M&G focuses on political analysis, investigative reporting and Southern African news. We also carry a number of titles from Independent Newspapers in South Africa, including the two main English language newspapers of the Western Cape; the Cape Argus and the Cape Times. While the Cape Times is the morning staple of many households in Cape Town, The Cape Argus is an afternoon newspaper unashamedly aimed at Cape Town's broader middle classes and focusing on the issues faced by the unique political climate of the city.
